SIZES Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 34 (38, 42, 46, 50, 54)"/
86.5 (96.5, 106.5, 117, 127, 137) cm
Length 18 (18 1/2, 19, 19 1/2, 20, 20)"/
45.5 (46.5, 48, 49, 51, 51) cm

MATERIALS

Vest

- 7 (9, 10, 11, 12, 13) 3.5oz/100g balls (60yds/55m) Tahki Yarns BABY TWEED 92% wool, 8% viscose shown in #05 olive tweed - discontinued [choose one of 6 altermate colors]
- One pair each size 13 and 15 (9 and 10mm) needles

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

- Stitch holders
- Three buttons, 1" diameter

Hat

- 2 balls in #05 olive tweed - discontinued [choose one of 6 altermate colors]
- One each size 13 and 15 (9 and 10 mm) circular needle, 16"/40cm long
- One set double pointed needles 15 (10 mm)

OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

- Pom Pom maker

Both

- Cable needle
- Stitch markers and Yarn needle

GAUGE

9 sts and 12 rows = 4"/10 cm in Reverse Stockinette stitch using larger needles

10-st Cable measures about 2 3/4" (6cm)

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

Three-Needle Bind Off: Place sts of pieces to be joined on separate needles, (or each end of circular needle), held 1 behind the other, with right sides facing each other, in left hand; with third needle, (same size or 1 size larger than used for knitting pieces), k2tog [one from front needle, one from back needle –1 st on right-hand needle], *k2tog [2 sts on right-hand needle], bind off 1 st in usual manner; repeat from * to end.

SPECIAL TERMS/ABBREVIATIONS

C3/1B Slip 1 st to cable needle, hold to back, k3, p1 from cable needle.

C3/1F Slip 3 st to cable needle, hold to front, p1, k3 from cable needle.

C6B Slip 3 st to cable needle, hold to back, k3, k3 from cable needle.

ssk Slip, slip, knit (dec) – Slip 2 sts, one at a time, knitwise, to right-hand needle, return the sts to left-hand needle in the turned position and knit them together through the back loops.

ssp Slip, slip, purl (dec) – Slip 2 sts, one at a time, knitwise, to right-hand needle, return the sts to left-hand needle in the turned position and purl them together through the back loops.

PATTERN STITCHES

K1, P1 Rib (multiple of 2 sts + 1 extra st)

Row 1: (WS) * K1, p1; repeat from * across, end k1.

Row 2: Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you. Repeat Row 2 for k1, p1 rib.

Reverse Stockinette stitch (Rev St st)

Purl on RS, knit on WS.

Cable Pattern (Panel of 10 sts)

Note Vest is work back and forth in rows; Hat is worked in-the-round.

Row/Round 1 (RS) K3, p4, k3.

Row/Round 2 and all WS rows/rnds

Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you.

Row/Round 3 C3/1F, p2, C3/1B.

Row/Round 5 P1, C3/1F, C3/1B, p1.

Row/Round 7 P2, C6B, p2.

Row/Round 9 P2, k6, p2.

Row/Round 11 P2, C6B, p2.

Row/Round 13 P1, C3/1B, C3/1F, p1.

Row/Round 15 C3/1B, p2, C3/1F.

Row/Round 16: Repeat Row/Round 2. Repeat Rows/ Rounds 1 – 16 for Cable.

BACK

Using smaller needles, cast on 44 (48, 52, 58, 62, 66) sts.

Begin Pattern

(WS) P0 (0, 0, 1, 1, 1), work k1, p1 rib over next 5 (7, 7, 9, 11, 11) sts, * place a marker (pm), p3, k2, p3, pm, work k1, p1 rib over next 5 (5, 7, 7, 7, 9) sts,

pm; repeat from * once, p3, k2, p3, pm, work k1, p1 rib over 5 (7, 7, 9, 11, 11) sts, p0 (0, 0, 1, 1, 1) st.

Continue in this manner; work even for 3 rows, end with a right-side row.

Change to larger needle.

Begin Pattern

(WS) * Knit across to marker (Rev St st); p3, m1, k2, m1, p3; repeat from * 2 times, knit to end (Rev St st)—50 (54, 58, 64, 68, 72) sts.

(RS) * Work in Rev St st to marker; beginning Row 1, work Cable across next 10 sts; repeat from * twice; work in Rev St st to end. Continue in pattern, working sts each side of Cables in Rev St st, until piece measures 9 (9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10, 10)", end with a wrong-side row.

Shape Armhole

(RS) Bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5) sts at beginning of next 2 rows, 2 (2, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts at beginning of next 2 rows—42 (44, 46, 48, 50, 52) sts remain.

Work even in pattern until armhole measures 8 (8, 8 1/2, 8 1/2, 9, 9)" from beginning of shaping, ending with a wrong-side row; pm each side of center 12 (12, 14, 14, 16, 16) sts for neck.

Shape Neck

Work in pattern across to marker; join a second ball of yarn and bind off center sts; work to end—15 (16, 16, 17, 17, 18) sts remain each side.

Working both sides at the same time, at each neck edge, dec 1 st every row twice—13 (14, 14, 15, 15, 16) sts remain each side for shoulders.

Work even until armhole measures 9 (9, 9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10)" from beginning of shaping.

Place sts on holders.

LEFT FRONT

Using smaller needles, cast on 20 (22, 24, 27, 29, 31) sts.

Begin Pattern

(WS) Work k1, p1 rib over next 7 (7, 9, 9, 11, 11) sts, place a marker (pm), p3, k2, p3, pm, work k1, p1 rib over next 5 (7, 7, 9, 9, 11) sts, p0 (0, 0, 1, 1, 1) st. Continue in this manner; work even for 3 rows, end with a right-side row. Change to larger needles.

Begin Pattern

(WS) Knit across to marker (Rev St st); p3, m1, k2, m1, p3; knit to end (Rev St st)—22 (24, 26, 29, 31, 33) sts.

(RS) Work in Rev St st to marker; beginning Row 1, work Cable across next 10 sts; work in Rev St st to end. Continue in pattern, working sts each side of Cable in Rev St st, until piece measures 9 (9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10, 10)", end with a wrong-side row.

Shape Armhole and Neck

(RS) At armhole edge (beginning of RS rows), bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5) sts once, 2 (2, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts once, and AT THE SAME TIME, beginning on first row of armhole shaping, at neck edge (end of RS rows), dec 1 st this row, every 4 rows 1 (1, 3, 3, 4, 4) times, every 6 rows 3 (3, 2, 2, 2, 2) times—13 (14, 14, 15, 15, 16) sts remain for shoulders. Work even until armhole measures 9 (9, 9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10)" from beginning of shaping.

Place sts on holder.

RIGHT FRONT

Using smaller needles, cast on 20 (22, 24, 27, 29, 31) sts.

Begin Pattern

(WS) P0 (0, 0, 1, 1, 1), work k1, p1 rib over next 5 (7, 7, 9, 11, 11) sts, place a marker (pm), p3, k2, p3, pm, work k1, p1 rib over next 7 (7, 9, 9, 9, 11) sts. Continue in this manner; work even for 3 rows, end with a right-side row. Change to larger needles

Begin Pattern

(WS) Knit across to marker (Rev St st); p3, m1, k2, m1, p3; knit to end (Rev St st)—22 (24, 26, 29, 31, 33) sts.

(RS) Work in Rev St st to marker; Beginning Row 1, work Cable across next 10 sts; work in Rev St st to end. Continue in pattern, working sts each side of Cable in Rev St st, until piece measures 9 (9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10, 10)", end with a wrong-side row.

Shape Neck and Armhole

(RS) Beginning this row, at neck edge (beginning of RS rows), dec 1 st this row, then every 4 rows 1 (1, 3, 3, 4, 4) times, every 6 rows 3 (3, 2, 2, 2, 2) times, and AT THE SAME TIME, at armhole edge (beginning of WS rows), bind off 2 (3, 3, 4, 5, 5) sts once, 2 (2, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts once—13 (14, 14, 15, 15, 16) sts remain for shoulders.

Work even until armhole measures 9 (9, 9 1/2, 9 1/2, 10, 10)" from beginning of shaping.

Place sts on holder.

FINISHING

Join shoulders using Three-Needle Bind Off method.

Armhole Bands

Using smaller needle, and pick up and knit 41 (43, 47, 49, 53, 55) sts evenly around armhole.

(WS) Knit 1 row.

(RS) Begin k1, p1 rib; work even for 3 rows, end with a right-side row.

(WS) Bind off all sts loosely in rib.

Neck/Button Band

Using smaller needle, beginning at center Back neck, pick up and knit 49 (51, 53, 55, 57, 59) sts evenly across Back neck, along left Front neck shaping and down center Front to lower edge.

(WS) Knit 1 row.

(RS) Begin k1, p1 rib; work even for 3 rows, end with a right-side row.

(WS) Bind off all sts loosely in rib.

Pm for 3 buttonholes on right Front, first 1" from lower edge, last at

beginning of neck shaping, and remaining 1 evenly spaced between.

Neck/Buttonhole Band

Using smaller needle, beginning at lower right Front edge, pick up and knit 49 (51, 53, 55, 57, 59) sts evenly up Front edge, along neck shaping, and across Back neck to center.

(WS) Knit 1 row.

(RS) Begin k1, p1 rib; and AT THE SAME TIME, work button holes opposite markers by [yo, k2tog].

Continuing in k1, p1 rib, work even for 2 rows, end with a right-side row.

(WS) Bind off all sts loosely in rib.

Sew center Back neck seam; sew side seams.

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends; sew buttons opposite buttonholes.

HAT

Using smaller circular needle, cast on 52 sts; join, being careful not to twist sts, place a marker for beginning of round.

Begin Rib Pattern

* K3, p2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1; repeat from * around.

Work even for 3 rounds. Change to larger circular needle.

Begin Cable Pattern

* K3, m1, p2, m1, k3, p5; repeat from * around—60 sts.

Round 1 Beginning Round 1 of Cable pattern, * work Cable across next 10 sts, p5; repeat from * around.

Rounds 2 – 12 Work even in pattern, ending Round 12 of Cable.

Shape Crown: Note Change to dpn as necessary. **Round 13** * Work Cable across next 10 sts, p2tog, p1, ssp; repeat from * around—52 sts remain.

Rounds 14 and 16 Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts as they face you.

Round 15 * Work Cable across next 10 sts, p3tog; repeat from * around—44 sts remain.

Round 17 * K2, ssk, p2, k2tog, k2, p1; repeat from * around—36 sts remain.

Round 18 * K2, ssk, k2tog, k2, p1; repeat from * around—28 sts remain.

Round 19 * K1, ssk, k2tog, k1, p1; repeat from * around—20 sts remain.

Round 20 * Ssk, k2tog, p1; repeat from * to end—12 sts remain.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12" tail. Using yarn needle threaded with tail, weave tail through remaining loops, pull tight to close top of Hat and fasten off securely on WS.

Pom pom

Make a pom pom and attach to top of hat.
