



CLARE ONE-BALL HAT

EASY

SIZES

One size

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Hat 8"/20.5cm tall x 17"/43 cm
circumference, not stretched

MATERIALS

- 1 ball **Tahki Yarns KIAWAH** 55% lambswool, 45% cotton (1.75oz/50g; 128yds/117m) in color **#24 Lead**
- One pair size 8 (5mm) needles **OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Yarn needle

GAUGES

22 sts and 24 rows = 4"/10cm in K3, p2 rib, not stretched

24 sts and 26 rows = 4"/10cm in Mock Rib Cable Pattern, not stretched

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGES

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

K2tog tbl: Knit 2 together (dec) – Knit 2 sts tog through the back loops.

P2tog: Purl 2 together (dec) – Purl 2 sts tog through the front loops.

PATTERN STITCHES

K3, p2 Rib (multiple of 5 sts + 3)

Mock Cable Pattern (multiple of 2 sts)

HAT

Cast on 94 sts.

Rib Row 1 (RS) K1, p2, *k3, p2; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Rib Row 2 Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts. Repeat Rib Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 3" from cast-on, ending with WS row.

Change to pattern:

NOTE: *The pattern rows involve varying stitch counts on Rows 1 and 2 due to the pattern stitch.*

Patt Row 1 (RS) K1, p2, *slip 1 purlwise, k2, pssso, p2; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Patt Row 2 P1, *k2, p1, yo, p1; repeat from * to last st, p1.

Patt Rows 3 and 4 Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.

Repeat Patt Rows 1-4 until piece measures 7" from beginning, ending with a Row 4.

Shape Crown

Dec Row (RS) K1, p2tog, *work next 3 sts in pattern as established, p2tog; repeat from * to last st, k1 – 19 decreases made.

(WS) P1, k1 *p1, yo, p1, k1; repeat from * to last st, p1.

Dec Row (RS) K1, p1, *k2tog tbl, k1, p1; repeat from * to last st, k1 – 18 decreases made.

(WS) P1, *k1, p2; repeat from * to last st, p1.

Dec Row (RS) K1, p1, *k2tog tbl, p1; repeat from * to last sts, k1 – 18 decreases made; 39 sts remain.

(WS) Knit the knit sts and purl the purl sts.

Dec Row (RS) K2tog tbl across row to last st, k1 – 19 sts remain.

Dec Row (WS) P2tog across to last stitch, p1 – 10 sts remain.

Cut yarn leaving a long tail for seaming.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, thread tail of yarn through remaining 10 sts. Pull tightly to close hole at top of HAT, pulling yarn tail to WS of piece.

Sew HAT seam together. Weave in ends.
